Communion Sunday

Primary Text: Acts 2:42-47 New International Version (NIV)

The Fellowship of the Believers

42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. 43 Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. 44 All the believers were together and had everything in common. 45 They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. 46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, 47 praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

Discussion Questions:

Describe what it means to be “devoted to the apostle’s teaching, to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer”.

How do you feel about the prospect of growing as a congregation?

What area of reaching out and loving people feels like a natural fit for you – for example sharing life skills (which skills?), reaching out to friends and family, connecting with students, serving and addressing neighborhood needs, conducting bible study, engaging in classes for people curious about Jesus, street evangelism, etc.

What can you do to promote unity and connect regularly with your brothers and sisters at Life Church? For example do you or are you willing to have dinner or hang out with people periodically, etc.?
