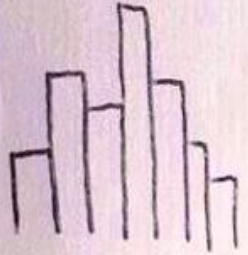


The New Normal...

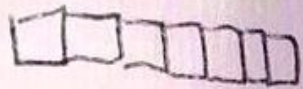
Change... will be adapt and remember what is important, or will we be overwhelmed by the change.

Side view

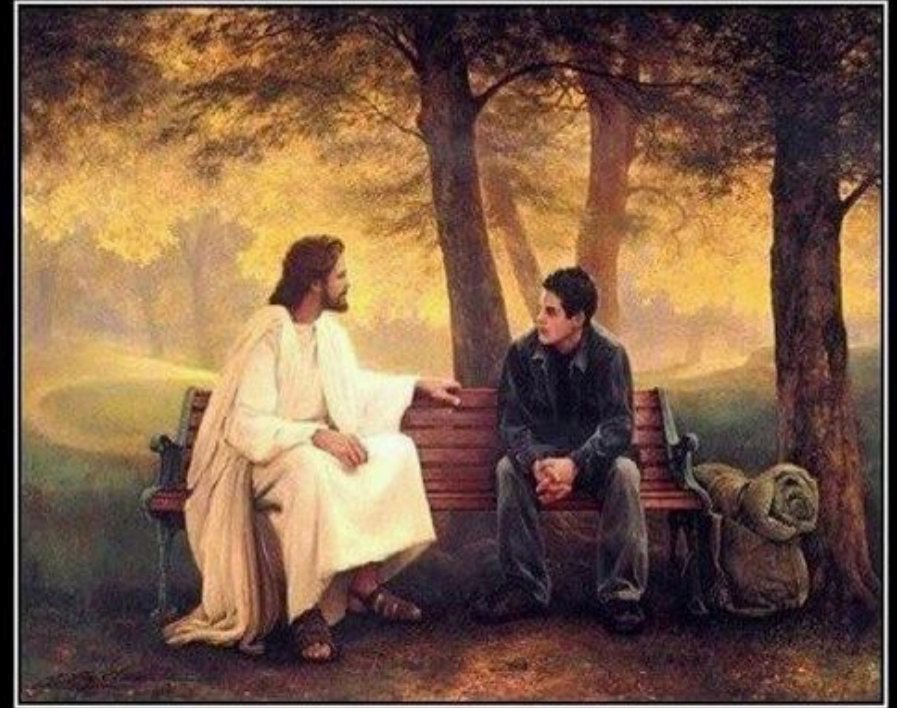


We see sin as

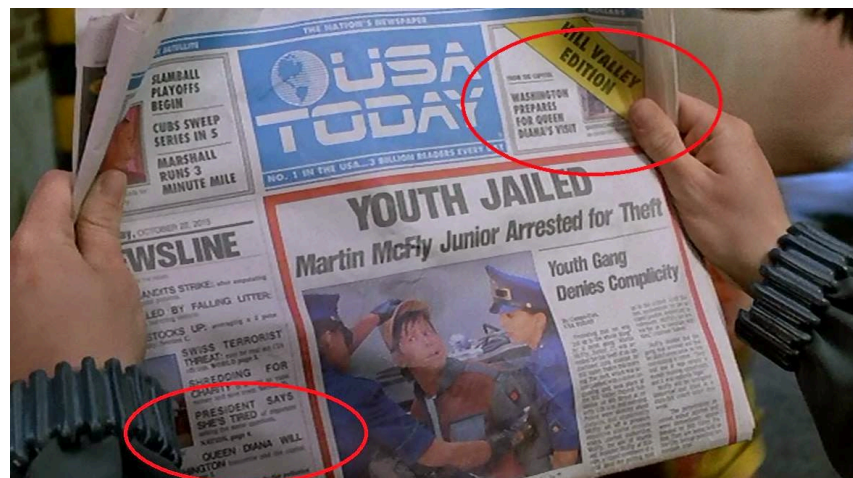

The New Normal is defined by the Old Normal
