- **Read the Passage: Matthew 25:31-46**

▼ **Overall Exegetical Idea**

- What you do or don't do for his body, you do or don't do for Jesus.

▼ **Determine Sermon's Purpose (what listeners should do)**

- Be faithful in readiness
- Be faithful in productivity.
- Be faithful in caring for your brothers and sisters - especially those who are being persecuted.
- Don't be passive or a spectator. Be intentional, purposeful, and make plans.

▼ **Be faithful in readiness**

- In the Parable of the Ten Virgins (Matthew 25:1-13) Jesus teaches that his followers must be faithful in readiness (i.e. keep watch).
- Without your lamp burning (Matthew 5:13-16) you can't be a part of the procession pointing to the bridegroom.

▼ **Be faithful in productivity.**

- in the Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25:14-30) Jesus teaches that his followers must be faithful in productivity.

▼ **Be faithful in caring for your brothers and sisters - especially those who are being persecuted.**

- ▼ The nations are being judged by how they treat Jesus' followers
  - A prophet's reward - Matthew 10:26-42
  - A cup of cold water - Mark 9:38-41
- Brothers of mine - Matthew 12:46-50
- In the Parable of the Sheep and the Goats (Matthew 25:31-46) Jesus teaches that his followers must be faithful in caring.
- Jesus is present in his body. What we do or fail to do for followers of Jesus, we do or fail to do for Jesus.
- People who genuinely receive followers of Jesus are on the path to becoming followers of Jesus themselves.

- Human beings are God's image-bearers. We represent God to the rest of creation and therefore to each other.
- Believers are subject to oppression for proclaiming the Good News. As a result, they may become hungry, thirsty, displaced, naked, sick, or imprisoned. Don't abandon them!
- **Don't be passive or a spectator. Be intentional, purposeful, and make plans.**
