HOW WE DO WHAT WE DO IS AS IMPORTANT AS WHAT WE DO.

**FAITH WITHOUT
REPS IS DEAD**



- Jesus did Extra Ordinary things with ordinary people...
- Haters are like competition that sharpen you. Why Judas? Why Satan... God saw him coming, Why let him come? Satan is the ultimate Hater, and sharpener of God's People. He literally is called the Adversary!
- God is calling us to Hustle (not the world's money based hustle, but to work hard for His kingdom. Faith without Works (Hustle) is Dead,
- To Hustle is put boundaries on what You CAN'T Do. Jesus had boundaries! One was to always put God First, to Pray first, etc. He had to say no to people when needed, We do ourselves, including saying no to ourselves... Boundaries make some upset. Judas was one..
- You know someone's heart by how they treat the lowly, and how they respond to when someone says no to them.

THE LIFE OF A CONSUMER/CREATOR IS DEALING WITH HATERS AND SOMETIMES BEING ONE WHEN NEEDED!

- Peter was a hot Head, and easily influenced at times, but had a good heart and loved God! He needed Correction. You can imagine what the other disciples thought of him when Jesus Restored him! He was the Captain of the Disciples... The other disciples and Jesus had things to say.
- Peter's Doctrinal mistake is detailed in Galatians 2, where he made a hypocritical withdrawal from eating with Gentile believers in Antioch out of fear of Jewish Christians from Jerusalem ("the circumcision group"), which implied that salvation required following Jewish laws like circumcision, contradicting the gospel of faith in Christ. This action, driven by social pressure, caused other Jewish believers, including Barnabas, to follow his hypocrisy, creating confusion and undermining the unity of the Church, leading Paul the Apostle to publicly confront him for not living in line with the truth of the gospel. (Gemini).
- Don't Forget Paul had Plenty of Haters too... He was a Pharisee, A double agent, Too soft spoken, (He literally put someone to death with his preaching), He did not have enough authority...

PRACTICAL ASPECTS OF
DISCIPLESHIP?**

THE LIFE OF A CONSUMER LEADS US TO BLEND IN, VERSUS COURAGEOUSLY STANDING WITH CHRIST.

Peter's Denial:

- **Fear of Identification and losing Jesus**: Peter was fearful of ridicule and being identified with Christ at that time. To be identified with Christ would have limited him following to see how Jesus was doing. Peter proved his courage a few times... He just attacked a man for Jesus being outnumbered... but people could laugh at him because his master was taken... If he was God how could he be taken?
- **Human Weakness**: Peter, like other disciples, failed to stay awake and pray as Jesus asked, showing his own spiritual frailty in a moment of crisis
- **Overconfidence**: Peter had previously declared he would never deny Jesus, but his actions proved his self-assurance was misplaced, highlighting his pride and lack of true courage under pressure.
- Peter thought he could blend in with the same guards who had just arrested Jesus and the crowd cheering his arrest. How many times have we thought the same thing? I want to fit into a group who might not be receptive to Christianity so I won't talk about my faith and they'll probably never know. Maybe I'll even laugh at their off-color jokes or join in on gossip and slander, or at least not object.

JESUS' HATERS

Jesus Arrested

⁴⁷ While he was still speaking a crowd came up, and the man who was called Judas, one of the Twelve, was leading them. He approached Jesus to kiss him, ⁴⁸ but Jesus asked him, “Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?”

⁴⁹ When Jesus' followers saw what was going to happen, they said, “Lord, should we strike with our swords?” ⁵⁰ And one of them struck the servant of the high priest, cutting off his right ear.

⁵¹ But Jesus answered, “No more of this!” And he touched the man's ear and healed him.

⁵² Then Jesus said to the chief priests, the officers of the temple guard, and the elders, who had come for him, “Am I leading a rebellion, that you have come with swords and clubs? ⁵³ Every day I was with you in the temple courts, and you did not lay a hand on me. But this is your hour—when darkness reigns.”

THE GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE

³⁹ And He came out and went, as was His habit, to the Mount of Olives; and the disciples also followed Him. ⁴⁰ Now when He arrived at the place, He said to them, "Pray that you do not come into temptation." ⁴¹ And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and *began* to pray, ⁴² saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done." ⁴³ [n] Now an angel from heaven appeared to Him, strengthening Him. ⁴⁴ And being in agony, He was praying very fervently; and His sweat became like drops of blood, falling down upon the ground]. ⁴⁵ When He rose from prayer, He came to the disciples and found them sleeping from sorrow, ⁴⁶ and He said to them, "Why are you sleeping? Get up and pray that you do not come into temptation."

LUKE 22: 54-60

HOW DO WE OVERCOME OUR HATE?

Peter Disowns Jesus

⁵⁴ Then seizing him, they led him away and took him into the house of the high priest. Peter followed at a distance. ⁵⁵ And when some there had kindled a fire in the middle of the courtyard and had sat down together, Peter sat down with them. ⁵⁶ A servant girl saw him seated there in the firelight. She looked closely at him and said, "This man was with him."

⁵⁷ But he denied it. "Woman, I don't know him," he said.

⁵⁸ A little later someone else saw him and said, "You also are one of them."
"Man, I am not!" Peter replied.

⁵⁹ About an hour later another asserted, "Certainly this fellow was with him, for he is a Galilean."

⁶⁰ Peter replied, "Man, I don't know what you're talking about!" Just as he was speaking, the rooster crowed. ⁶¹ The Lord turned and looked straight at Peter. Then Peter remembered the word the Lord had spoken to him: "Before the rooster crows today, you will disown me three times." ⁶² And he went outside and wept bitterly.

WE HAVE BEEN CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST AND SHARE IN THE HUSTLE OF FAITH... WORKS THAT COME AS A RESULT OF FAITH

- **Paul Opposes Cephas**

- ¹¹ When Cephas came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face, because he stood condemned. ¹² For before certain men came from James, he used to eat with the Gentiles. But when they arrived, he began to draw back and separate himself from the Gentiles because he was afraid of those who belonged to the circumcision group. ¹³ The other Jews joined him in his hypocrisy, so that by their hypocrisy even Barnabas was led astray.
- ¹⁴ When I saw that they were not acting in line with the truth of the gospel, I said to Cephas in front of them all, "You are a Jew, yet you live like a Gentile and not like a Jew. How is it, then, that you force Gentiles to follow Jewish customs?"
- ¹⁵ "We who are Jews by birth and not sinful Gentiles ¹⁶ know that a person is not justified by the works of the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in ¹⁷ Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no one will be justified.
- ¹⁷ "But if, in seeking to be justified in Christ, we Jews find ourselves also among the sinners, doesn't that mean that Christ promotes sin? Absolutely not! ¹⁸ If I rebuild what I destroyed, then I really would be a lawbreaker.
- ¹⁹ "For through the law I died to the law so that I might live for God. ²⁰ I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. ²¹ I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness could be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing!" ²²

WHAT IS THE MISSION... THE WHAT, AND THE HUSTLE... THE MINDSET GOD WANTS FOR US?

- To Build his kingdom... I have seen a lot of Doom and Gloom about the American Economy recently.... What if God was to tell you the economy was going to collapse Next month, how would you operate? How would you Hustle to be in a good Position? The Process is not that hard actually- Get out of Debt, Save automatically, Invest in things that will last (with diversification- Maybe in things that are not the world's currency- the dollar), Use Tax advantaged methods like 401k's Roth IRA's, etc. Find jobs that are Recession Proof, Live below your means if possible, But Get going!!!
- If you knew the date... They you would act differently.. God will not tell us the date of Jesus' return, because the How he wants us to live is to Hustle for him everyday, as if he was coming back today!
- How do we get that On fire mindset? Love as if there is no tomorrow!

DEALING WITH YOUR HATERS

- God's Missions are not just for others... The Missions are for us as well. Our mission is the Game God has given us... and the Process and the Journey make us stronger and build our Faith.
- Satan is our stongest hater, but with our flesh, our Pride, the World we have Haters on every side, and even on the inside... So Humility, Prayer, Routines of excellence are key....
- You know a tree by it's fruit. What things are you doing regularly that show You are a disciple of Christ?
- What are our Issues God needs to work on with us? Do they disqualify us from Service? Sometimes...Peter is an example of this... but restoration and working on things is part of our walk.
